## Other Clinic Services

The TechniClinic also provides other services and programs to improve the health of students and the school community. These include:

**YOUTH DEVELOPMENT** — The TechniClinic offers community service programs, such as Peer Health Education, which give Oakland Tech students an opportunity to develop their leadership, teamwork, critical thinking and public speaking skills, as well as many other skills that will benefit them in life.

**CASE MANAGEMENT** — Links students to programs and services on and off campus that the TechniClinic cannot provide.

**COORDINATED SCHOOL HEALTH** — The TechniClinic spearheaded a pilot program to bring together support service providers and conduct programming in school health areas of need. 2005's Spring Health Fair and the Peace Summit to address school and community violence are examples. Staff Health Promotion was also a major focus.

**HEALTH INSURANCE ENROLLMENT** — The TechniClinic has staff trained to help youth and families enroll in health insurance programs they may qualify for.

**ADVOCACY** — The TechniClinic advocates for adolescent health rights and local, state and federal policies that support their rights to access quality, comprehensive, culturally-competent health care.
