## Girls Incorporated of Alameda County Release of Information (Two Parts) (Parents/Guardians)

### Part 1

#### Statement of confidentiality

Participants in Girls Inc. programs have the right to confidentiality and privacy. This means we will not share any of your child's/youth's personal information unless you give us written permission to do so. We ask for your permission, because on occasion, we may need to share information on a limited basis, to assist you, your daughter or youth in your care in order to get educational, health, social or community services needed.

This permission includes tracking girls' school attendance and test scores in specific subject areas for evaluation purposes.

#### Exceptions to confidentiality

There are instances, however, when we would need to break confidentiality. These instances would be if your daughter/son or youth in your care let us know that they were being hurt by someone (like physical, sexual or emotional abuse) or if they or any member of your family indicated that they wanted to hurt themselves or someone else.
